#### The story

#### Vocabulary - strengths and weaknesses

When you are asked a question about your weaknesses, it is best to mention a skill or trait that does not affect your performance at work. Look up the meaning and pronunciation of any new words in your dictionary. Stress the words in bold.

#### Q: How would you describe your strengths?

I'm very thorough and I work well in a team.

I have a good sense of humour and I've been told that I put guests at ease.

My current boss says I'm very efficient and I'm always punctual.

#### Q: What weaknesses do you have?

I'm a perfectionist so I sometimes stay back at work to check everything is OK.
